What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that is sent to and stored on your computer, smartphone, or other devices to access the internet whenever you visit a website, if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. Cookies are functional because they allow the website to recognize the user's device. Use of cookies:

Cookies are small text files sent from a website and stored in the customer's web browser while visiting the website. Cookies can store information such as (encrypted) passwords, usernames, shopping carts, specific preferences, etc., allowing visitors to visit websites multiple times without entering the same information. We respect your privacy and all rights related to your online presence. The purpose of the company uses cookies is to collect information about visitors to the website and other services the company provides.

By continuing to use our website, you agree to our use of cookies on this website.

Our cookies may use the following:

Strictly necessary cookies:

These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. For example, they include cookies that allow you to log into secure areas of our website, such as the Client Login, our Demo Account Page, or our Research Centre.

Analytics / Performance cookies:

These cookies allow us to recognize and count visitors, see how visitors move around our site as they use it, and estimate and report the total audience size and traffic. This assistance will help us improve how our website works, for example: by ensuring that users find what they are looking for easily. All information about how you use our website is collected anonymously. The service we use is Google Analytics, an analytic web service provided by Google. Functional cookies:

They are used to recognize you when you return to our website, complete online forms, and log onto the website. This will allow us to personalize our content for you and remember your search preferences.



Session cookies:

They are used when you are logged onto an application, and it remembers that you are logged in when you navigate the website, for example: where you register online for a Prime Quotes account. However, when you close your browser, the cookie is deleted, so when you revisit the website, you'll need to sign in again.

Third parties

Please note that third parties (including execution brokers or providers of external services such as web traffic analysis services) may also use cookies over which we may have no control. When we include links to other websites, please note that they will have their own privacy and cookie policies that will check the use of any information you submit. We recommend that you read their policies as Prime Quotes is not responsible or liable for their security operations.
